In higher education mostly lecture method is used by teachers in classroom. Although, Lecture Method is useful in completing large content in less time but there are many limitations of this method that is, teacher is always dominating in class and students become passive listener only. The class becomes teacher centred, only a few students are interacting with teacher and many students

could not clear their doubts in classroom. There are some other teaching methods which have been using in higher education like Constructive Methods. Demonstration, Discussion, Story Telling, Role Play, Visit, Project, Assignment, Quiz, Problem Solving, Question Answer, Seminar and Conference method, etc. But only limited number of teachers and institutions are using these methods regularly. A new paradigm of teaching and learning is needed to increase the pupil's active participation, perception and cognitive development. The transfer of textual learning contents to visual learning content. This transition is more effective in the learning through innovative pedagogy and effective Teaching Learning.
