FEEDBACK EVALUATION COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT 2022 -

Feedback Evaluation Committee, is a committee which formed by the IQAC of the College to deal with the feedback collected from the various stake holders of the college viz. students, teachers, alumni, parents, and employers at least once in a year. The feedback is needed so as to enable the Principal as a leader and his team as a whole to evaluate the progress of the institution. By knowing the furtherance of the institution and even the hindrance in its path if exist, the Principal would be able to bring some change or modification in and around as needed for the overall improvement. It is also very needful for the teacher to evaluate the effectiveness of the pedagogy being used in teaching-learning process so that he/she would know if to continue with, or to replace it if needed.

In order to get some of those needful information, this time the committee has distributed feedback forms to alumni in a random manner and had also collect the same. The feedbacks had been evaluated and also analysed.

The evaluated and analysed feedbacks are submitted herewith.

Questionnaires and Feedback Analysis

Received from the Outgoing students batch 2019-22

Questionnaire was forwarded to the students via Google form (Structure of questionnaire enclosed). Out 110 outgoing students only 69 responded (62.73%).

1. As to find out how much did the teachers covered the syllabus at the end of the session, the question was asked as it appears in Q1 which states: How much of the Syllabus was covered in the class?

For the above question, the scale rating is 5 and it is ranging in the form of percentage as below:

85-100%., 70-84%, 55-69%, 30-54%.and below 30%.

From the 69 responses, 37.7% claimed that the syllabus was 70-84% covered in the class, and 55.1% claimed that it was 85-100% covered. Very less claimed it to be between 55-69%, and very insignificant claimed it to be below 30% covered.

2. It is also felt that it is needed for the administrative authority to know whether the teacher is fully prepared or not before entering the class, regarding with this enquiry, the question was asked as it appears in Q2: How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

For the above question, the rating scale is 5, ranging from the 'Thoroughly' 'Satisfactorily' 'Rarely' to 'Poorly' and 'Never'. From the 69 responses, there are 31.9% who claimed it to be thoroughly, and 65.2% who claimed it to be satisfactorily.

3. As to enable the administrative authority to know about the communication skill and fluency of the teachers the question was asked as it appears in Q3: How well were the teachers able to communicate?

For the above question, the scale used is 5, ranging from 'Always effective', 'Sometimes effective', 'Satisfactorily' to 'Not very effective' and 'Very poor'.

From the 69 responses, there are 56.5% who claimed it to be 'always effective', 21.7% as 'satisfactorily' and 20.3% claimed it to be sometime effective.

4. As to enable the administrative authority to know about the teachers approach to teaching question was asked as it appears in Q4: The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as:

The scale used for the above question is 5 ranging from 'excellent' 'very good' 'fair' 'good' and 'poor'.

From the 69 responses, there is 24.6% who claimed it to be 'excellent', 52.2% claimed it to be 'very good' and 18.8% claimed it to be 'good' and very insignificant claimed it to be 'poor'.

- 5. As to enable administrative authority to know about the way the internal evaluation process is being carried by the teachers, the statement is framed with the 5 rating scale ranging from 'Always fair' to 'Unfair'.
 - From the above 69 responses, 52.2% claimed it to be 'Always fair', 33.3% as 'Usually fair', 13% claimed as 'Sometimes unfair'.
- 6. As to enable the admistrative authority to know weither the teachers did or not discussed with the students on their performance in assignments, the question is being asked as it appear in Q6 with scale 5 ranging from 'Always' to 'Very rarely'.

 From the 69 responses, 71% claimed it to be 'Always', 17.4% claimed as 'Very
 - From the 69 responses, 71% claimed it to be 'Always', 17.4% claimed as 'Very frequently'.
- 7. The administrative authority wanted to know if the College had ever arranged any programme such as students exchange and field visit for students. Based on that the statement was framed as it appears in the paper which stated: The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students.
 - The rating for the above question was starting from the 'Regularly' upto the 'Never' in a scale of 5points.
 - From the 69 responses, 37.7% claimed it to be 'Regularly', 31.9% claimed it to be 'Often', and 23.2% claimed it to be 'Sometimes'.
- **8.** As to enable the administrative authority to know the effectiveness of teaching being carried by the teachers, a statement is stated as: The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
 - For the above question also the scale used is 5points ranging from 'Significantly' to 'Not at all'.
 - From the 69 responses, 49.3% rate it as 'Significantly', 24.6% rate it as 'Moderately' and 18.8% rate it as 'Significantly'
- 9. The administrative authority wanted to know if the students get multiple opportunities for their learning, a statement was put as: The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow. This statement carries 5points scale ranging from 'Strongly agree' to 'Strongly disagree'. From the 69 responses 56.5% responded as 'agree' and 39.1% as 'strongly agree'.
- 10. The administrative authority wanted to know how frequently have teachers informed the students about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. Based on this a statement: Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes. This statement is a 5point scales varies from 'Every time' to 'Never'. From the 69 responses 58% claimed it to be 'Every time', 29% claimed it to be 'Usually' and 11.6% claimed it to be 'Sometimes'.

- 11. The administrative authority had appointed Mentor-mentees group, therefore wanted to know if their mentor did any follow up with their assigned task. Based on this, a statement: Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you, was given with a rating of 5point scale ranging from 'Always' to 'Very rarely'. From the 69 responses, 49.3% say 'Always', 33.3% say 'Very frequently' and very few say 'Occasionally'.
- 12. To find out if teachers apply the method of Illustration with Examples in their teaching process, the question has been given as it appears in Q12: The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and application. It is a 5 points scale question which range from 'Always' to 'Very rarely'. From the 69 responses, 68.8% claimed it to be 'Always', 23.3% as very frequently, and 14.5% as 'sometimes'.
- 13. To find out if teachers identify the strength of the students and encourage them by providing them right level of challenges, question was asked as: 'The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges' the scale of this question is 5 points which vary from 'Always' to 'Very rarely'. From the 69 responses, there are 58% who claimed it to be as 'Always', 23.2% as 'Very frequently' and 14.5% as 'Sometimes'.
- 14. To find out if teachers help the students to overcome their weaknesses, a question was asked as: 'Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them'. It is a 5 points scale question which vary from 'Always' to 'Very rarely'. From the 69 responses, 55.1% claimed it to be 'Always', 24.6% as 'Very frequently' and 17.4% as 'Sometimes'.
- 15. To find out if the institution made any effort to improve the teaching learning process, a statement was put as: The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. This statement carries 5points which carries from 'Strongly agree' to 'Strongly disagree'. From the 69 responses 23.2% claimed it to be 'Strongly agree', 62.3% as 'Agree'.
- 16. To find out if teachers encourage the students to participate in extra curricular activities, a statement was put as: Teachers encourage you to participate in extra curricular activities. This statement carries 5points scale which varies from 'Strongly agree' to 'Strongly disagree'. From the 69 responses, 42% claimed it as 'Strongly agree', and 50.7% as 'Agree'.
- 17. To find out if teachers use student-centric method for enhancing learning experiences, a statement was put as: The institute/teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences. This statement carries 5 points which vary from 'To a

- great extent' to 'Very little'. From the 69 responses, 34.8 % claimed it to be 'Very little', 50.7% as 'Moderate' and 8.7 as 'Little'.
- 18. The statement which goes as: Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work. This statement carries 5 points scale which vary from 'To a great extent' to 'Very little'. From the 69 responses 39.1% claimed it to be as 'To a great extent', 47.8% as 'Moderate'.
- 19. To find out about the percentage of teachers who use ICT while teaching, a question was asked as: 'What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc while teaching'. This question carries 5point scale which vary from 'Above 90%' to 'Below 29%'. From the 69 responses, 44.9% claimed it to be in between 70-89%, and 36.2% claimed it to be in between 50-69%.
- 20. To find out if the overall quality of teaching-learning process is good or not, a statement was put as: The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good. This statement carries 5points scale which vary from 'Strongly agree' to 'Strongly disagree'. From the 69 responses, 29.4% claimed it as 'Strongly agree', and 66.2% as 'Agree'.
- 21. The administration authority wants the students to rate the student-teacher relationship through a question which goes as: How do you rate the student-teacher relationship in the college as a whole. This question carries 5points scale which varies from 'Excellent' to 'Poor'. From the 69 responses, 26.1% claimed it to be 'Excellent', 44.9% say it to be 'Very good' and 23.2% as 'Good'.
- 22. The administration authority, wanted to know from the students how will they talk about their College, asked a question which goes like: After leaving the College how will you talk about it? This question carries 5 points scale which varies from 'Very proudly' to 'Contentedly' 'Strongly satisfactorily', 'Satisfactory' and 'Not very satisfactory'. From the 69 responses, 63.8% say 'Very proudly', 14.5% say 'Contentedly', and 17.4% say 'Satisfactory'.
- 23. To find out about their opinion on the existing Library in the College, the question was being asked as: What is your opinion about the Library holding for the course? This question carries 5 points scale which vary from 'Very helpful', 'Helpful', 'Somewhat Helpful', 'Average', 'Below average'. From the 69 responses, 39.1% say that it is 'Very helpful', and 50.7% say it to be 'Helpful'.
- 24. The administrative authority also wanted to know how the students find the non-teaching staff by asking a question which goes like: How do you rate administrative and non-teaching staff? This question carries 5 points scale which vary from 'To a great extent' to 'Below average'. From the 69 responses 36.2% rated it as 'To a great extent', and 49.3% as 'Moderately'.

25. The administrative authority wanted also to see how the students would rate the quality of teaching-learning process through a statement which goes as: The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good. This statement carries 5 points scale which vary from 'Strongly agree' to 'Strongly disagree'. From the 69 responses, 26.1% claimed it to be 'Strongly agree' and 65.2% as 'Agree'.





4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as





